

Servant of the Honorable John Bull of Somerset County Sheriff of the County of Somerset otherwise called James summoned to show unto Henry Lower and Edward Waters his Executors of the last will and Testament of Thomas Lower Deceased of England that he should have the sum of eight pounds Current Money of Maryland which from them he unjustly detains and seizes — And whereas the said Henry and Edward by George Heywood their Attorney say that whereas the said Henry and Edward by their Attorney on the 15th day of March in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty seven by his Certain Bill Obligatory with the Seal of the said Henry and Edward sealed and to the Court here shown the date whereof is the same day and Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty seven did bind himself his heirs &c. in the Penal sum of eight pounds Current Money of Maryland to be paid to the said Thomas in his Life time in the sum of four pounds Current Money of Maryland to be paid to the said Thomas his heirs &c. as before to the true payment whereof the said Henry and Edward after the death of the said Thomas to demand and have of the said Henry and Edward eight pounds Current Money of Maryland whereas the said Henry and Edward in fact say that the said Henry and Edward after the death of the said Thomas the said Thomas in his Life time with the said Henry and Edward after the death of the said Thomas the said Thomas to pay altogether both Proposed and Still do Proposed and unjustly detain to the Manifest Delay of the Execution of the last will and Testament of the said Thomas and to the Damage of the said Henry and Edward eight pounds Current Money of Maryland and thereof they bring Suit and Suit and bring Suit to the said Court the said Henry and Edward are Executors of the Will of the said Thomas and thereof both the Administration and sequestration —
