Informed against the wherein shall and singular the Person for being soe and by the said fully -
understanding it is considered by the said Justice that the said Catherine Waller for the offence of Piracy and
whereupon the said Catherine Waller paid the sum of thirty Shillings of Money for the offence of Piracy
hath and payed the same with all due willingness given to her. According to the sufficient
thereupon unto the said Captain Waller together with John Simpson felon and his complices her selfe & the
said Justice and in their presence acknowledged themselves to have the said Captain the
1st Day of March Three pounds of Money of Maryland of their own goods Chancery Lands and Towne
Inland & severally to the said Captain his sonnes & Successors to be made and levied if it
happen that the said Captain doth not pay the Justices of Chancery County Court before the eighth
day of March Anno Domini MDCCCLXII the sum of thirty Shillings Currant for her fine P. V.
