

Stevens White late of Somerset County Gentleman hath removed in a secret manner from the place of his abode and carried away part of his substance and hath fled from Justice and it hath this Day made Appear to me by the above Oath of Michael Holland and the Bond which Annexed that the said White is indebted to him in the sum of thirty eight pounds nine Shillings and four pence current money of Maryland by the said Bond in v. penalty of eighty nine pounds twelve Shillings and six pence current money conditioned for the payments of forty four pounds sixteen Shillings and three pence the three fourths of the said sum of forty four pounds sixteen Shillings and three pence is due to you as Attachment Against the Lands Tenements Goods Chattels Rights and Credits of the said Stevens White for the said sum of eighty nine pounds twelve Shillings and six pence current money of Maryland in v. usual manner and according to the Directions of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided for the said Michael Holland and for so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant which also include the Incident Costs & win under my hand this 20<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1760

Somerset's & Frederick's Absolute For and Deputy of the Province of Maryland and Avalon and Baron of Baltimore to the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command you that you attach any the Goods and Chattels and Tenements Credits of Stephen White late of Somerset County and if they shall be found in your Bailiwick to the value of Eighty nine pounds twelve Shillings and six pence current money of Maryland and eight hundred pounds of Tobacco and whereas you have the same attached a any part thereof the same in your custody safe keep so that you have the same before our Justice of our County Court of Somerset to be held at Calverton on the third Tuesday of June Next there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly made for the use of a certain Michael Holland Jun<sup>r</sup> unless the said Stephen White by himself or his attorney shall Appear and Answer unto the said Michael Holland in v. plea of Debt & pleading the Law and that by Good and Lawful means of your Bailiwick you make known unto the person or persons in whose hands you make known the same Attachment that he or she or they have why the same Goods Chattels and Credits so attached in his or their hands ought not to be condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided if he or she or they shall answer or how you shall execute this Writ that you make known unto our said Justice at the Day and place of our said Court there this Writ Witness Isaac Handy Esq<sup>r</sup> Justice of our said Court the 21<sup>st</sup> Day of March in the 4<sup>th</sup> Year of our Dominion of Anno Domini 1760
