now h'ntt at a Court of his Lordship held at Bristol on the 2d Day of March Commanded by him before the Justices thereof (as the Justices in his proper person and had a hearing of the Justices of which he will and intend with his Lordship but for the service of the Justices of the same & his expenses about the premises submitted himself a fine with his said Lordship and to himself upon favor of the Court V.
