 said Pigg and against the peace of his Lordship the Right Hon. the said Lordship that is now his  
 good Pleas and Government &c. Thereupon it is Comanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that  
 he should take the said Andrew Francis Chancy of the County of Somerset to wit at Court of his Lordship holden at Princes Anne Town the third Tuesday of March  
 Comedien of 62 before the Justice thereof of the said Lordship in his proper person and had a hearing  
 of the prosecution of the said Lordship but for the saving of the  
 Labor and Expenses about the premises submit himself at fine with his said Lordship and put  
 himself upon favour of the Court &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by  
 the Court fully understood it is Considered by the Court here that the said Andrew Francis Chancy for  
 the offence aforesaid which said Andrew Francis Chancy present heron Court is fined for the offence  
 of the sum of One Shilling & Money which he paid to the Sheriff for the use of the said Lordship &c.

 said Lordship that he will not contend with his said Lordship but for the saving of the  
 Labor and Expenses about the premises submit himself at fine with his said Lordship and put himself  
 upon favour of the Court &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court  
 fully understood it is Considered by the Court here that the said John Walker for the offence aforesaid  
 be taken &c. which said John Walker present heron Court is fined for the offence of the sum  
 of five Shillings & Money which he paid to the Sheriff for the use of his Lordship &c.
