Miller being both lame and were chosen upon that day who to say the truth of the Breach of being Struck & Jured and Learning upon this Oath by the said Lewis Lewis as Guilty of the Breach in the Declaration of Marriages in Manner and Form as the said John above against him both Complaind and Appoyed the Damages of the said John by Decision of the Breach beyond his Cost and Charges by him about his Suit in that part Appoyed to five pounds eight Shillings and Ten pence halfe penny of Money and for three Cost and Charges to One pound of Shaves - Therefore it is considered that the said John shall recover against the said Lewis Lewis Tithe of the Damages of the said Lewis Lewis in sum of five pounds eight Shillings and Ten pence halfe penny - Damaige of Shaves for his Cost and Charges of the said John by the Court hereof his Apoyntment of Shaves - Adjudged which said Damages in the whole Amount to five pounds eight Shillings and Ten pence halfe penny - Damaige of Shaves and the said Lewis Lewis in May 1662

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should be and him should safe Ley so that he might have his Body before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be hold at Business Ann June the third Sunday of August Anno Domini One thousand six hundred and sixty One to Answer unto Alexander Stuart of the County of Westmoreland the life of the said day is given to the said Alexander Stuart

At which day here Com the said Alex Stuart by Juwal Bell his Attorney and the Sheriff Lewis John Dennis Quaker now has returned that he had before the said Thomas Ashworth where by at this day he had ready to Answer the said Alexander Stuart of the County of Westmoreland in the said County Court

Wherupon the said Thomas Ashworth at the prayer of the said Alex Stuart is Adjudged to Give special Bail to the like of Thersayon a certain Sum of Money in his proper Bond under Seal of the said Thomas Ashworth and Apoynted upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea of the said Alex Stuart should be therein Committed against the said Thomas Ashworth that he the said Thomas Ashworth should be therein Committed that then he the said Thomas Ashworth should pay and Safely unto the said Alex Stuart the Judgment of the Court Thersayon - Under his hand in Execution of which Judgment to the Sheriff of the County of Westmoreland he has given his body in the said County Court

Wherupon the said Thomas Ashworth took in his place W. Sturgeon and his Attorney at Law against the said Alex Stuart of the County of Westmoreland And Thersayon at the Prayer of the Justice of the Peace of the County of Westmoreland to be held at Business Ann June the third Sunday of November then next following in the State that now Serving to the Justice of the Peace At which day here Com as well the said Alex Stuart as the said Thomas Ashworth by their Attorney of the County of Westmoreland Complaind against the said Thomas in the plea of the said Alex Stuart in sum following - Somewhat so Thomas Ashworth the said Alex Stuart was Attached to Answer unto Alexander Stuart of Westmoreland County that he should pay to Thomas on the Twenty second day of May Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and Sixty one of the County of Westmoreland in the sum of Nineteen pounds fifteen Shillings and One penny of Money of Maryland for the Articles in the account hereto annexed Mentioned and he thereof Indebted being the said Thomas on Consideration thereof afterwards until the day and year a part of the said upon himself did Apoynt and to the said Alexander Stuart and therewith fully Promise that he the said Thomas when he should be taken afterwards Required unto the said Alexander he would faithfully pay and Content Nevertheless the said Thomas has Promised and Apoyntment of the said Alex Stuart
