The Red Oak above mentioned Stoops to the Southwards and Stands on the East Side of Tinslin near the head thereof about
200 yds from the Branch
Roger Nicholas of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland aged about 56 years being sworn on the holy Evangelists
of Almighty God Depoeth as followeth that about nineteen years ago he and Robert Ellis and John Whight did this
Depoent that the Oak was now at (the same as that in the two Depositions above) was abouder of Henry Dashiell's Land
Further South
Levin Dashiell of Somerset County of the Province of Maryland aged 50 years being sworn on the holy Evangelists
of Almighty God Depoeth as followeth that about Twenty years ago this Depoent was brought by Henry Dashiell's Land with
Several Others in Company and showed them the first bounder of his Land it being a dead fallen White Oak which lay
in this place a near and further South
John Stephens aged about 50 years being sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God Depoeth as followeth
that his father and Henry Dashiell had showed him a fallen tree which they both told him had been used in the time
of the first Bounder of the said Henry Dashiell's Land and the second bounder of John Stephens Land which tree the
Depoent said lay at a near the place where we now are and further South
John Stephens

John Dashiell of Somerset County in the Province of Maryland aged about fifty years being sworn on the holy
Evangelists of Almighty God Depoeth as followeth that about Twenty years ago Henry Dashiell showed him a fallen
tree which lay at a near the place where we now are and told him it was the first bounder of his Land and further
South
The tree mentioned in the three last Depositions in quite gone and there is no place where it stood
showed only these Depoents a Cedar post marked with Letter Notches on the West end of the post called
Wolf trap Branch and Lumbermen Bay Branch
John Dashiell aged being sworn on the holy Evangelists of Almighty God Depoeth as followeth that
about thirty years ago his father showed him a White Oak the stump of which was now at which he told him
was the first bounder of John Stephens Land and further South
John Dashiell

The Stump above mentioned stands near the Mouth of Gods Spring out of Tiggwin Creek which Creek divides the
Land of John Stephens from that of John Dashiell
