James Frederick Absolute Lord, Proprietor of the Province of Maryland, Avalon Lord  
Baron of Baltimore & to the Sheriff of Somerset County greeting we command you that  
you attach any the goods Chattels Lands, Tenements Rights and Credits of Stephen  
White late of Somerset County Gent, if they shall be found in your County with to the  
Value of Twenty five Pounds current money of Maryland, eight hundred pounds of  
Tobacco and when you have of same attached or any part thereof of same in your  
Custody safe keep so that you have the same when our Justices of our County Court  
of Somerset to be held at Guinea Arms Towns on the third Tuesday of June Next  
they there to be condemned according to Act of Assembly to and/or to be  
Sold to the highest bidder unless said Stephen White by himself or his Counsel Attorney shall  
appear and Answer unto said Smith Ansoy in a plea of Debt & Answering  
to Law and that by good and Lawfull men of your County with you make known  
unto of Persons or Persons in whose hands you make of same attachment that  
be she or they be and appear before our Justices of our County Court of Somerset  
to be held as aforesaid to shew Cause if any he she or they have why of same goods  
Chattels and Credits so attached in his her or their hands ought not to be  
condemned and Execution thereof had and made according to Act of  
Assembly in such Case made & provided if to here here or there it shall seem  
that you shall execute this Writ that you make known unto  
Our said Justices at day and place aforesaid have you then three the Writ

& year of my Richard Row & John Sanford good and Lawfull men of my  
County with I made known unto of said Thomas Newbold to be and appear  
before of Justices within named at the time and place therein Mentioned  
to shew Cause if any he hath why the said sum should not be condemned  
Towards satisfying the said Smith his Debt aforesaid as by aforesaid Writ
