

That the said Joseph Venable Guardian as of his heirs &c. do not comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship as of and do not deliver up unto the said Orphan his heirs &c. said Guardian or Guardians all the Estate personal of the said Orphan that he shall take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly who ever the same should be Legally Required &c.

William Robins an Orphan of his Deceased Parents is bound out by the Court here as an Apprentice according to Act of Assembly in such Case provided unto William Robins of Somerset County Ship Carpenter until he the said William Robins should arrive at the Age of Twenty one years the said William Robins to serve his said Master the full term of seven years the said Apprentice his said Master well and faithfully he shall serve his servants keep his Commandments Lawfully and honestly everywhere willingly he shall do and in all things as of and faithful Apprentice he shall demean himself towards his said Master and all his during the term of seven years In Consideration of which the said said Robins present herein Court in his proper person Covenanteth with the Justices of the Law that he the said Robins shall and will during the term of seven years his said Apprentices the trade of a Ship Carpenter and Navigation through Mercantile sailing and at the Expiration of his said Apprentices give him a New Suit of Cloaths of Broad Cloth One and above his common wearing Cloaths and likewise find and provide for his said Apprentices meat drink washing Dyeing and Clothing sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of seven years

Whereupon the said Robins is Ordered to give Security to comply with the Commandment of the Court the said Robins with Nehemiah Silman and George Doby of Somerset County planters his Securities all present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledged themselves bound unto the said William Robins in the sum of thirty pounds of Money of Maryland of their own Goods Chattels Lands and Tenements jointly and severally to the use of the said William Robins his heirs and Assigns to be made and Levied if it happen that the said Robins do not during the term of seven years his said Apprentices the trade of a Ship Carpenter and Navigation as before through Mercantile sailing and at the Expiration of his said Apprentices do not give him a New Suit of Cloaths of Broad Cloth one and above his common wearing Cloaths and do not likewise find and provide for his said Apprentices meat drink washing Dyeing and Clothing sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of seven years

Nathaniel Thrift of Somerset County Justice of the Peace came herein Court in his proper person and prays that he may be permitted to keep an Ordinary or house of Entertainment in the County of Somerset for the use of the Justices of the Peace and other persons who shall be sent unto them respectively shall be sent unto which is by the Court hereunto him Granted he giving Security as the Law directs to keep Good Order and Quietness in his Ordinary or house of Entertainment as of &c. Whereupon Nathaniel Thrift Discretion and John White of Somerset County planters his Securities all present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledged themselves bound unto the said Nathaniel Thrift the Right Sheriff the said County of the province of Maryland in thirty pounds of Money of Maryland of their own Goods Chattels Lands and Tenements jointly and severally to the use of his said Justice of the Peace his heirs and Assigns to be made and Levied if it happen that the said Nathaniel Thrift do not keep Good Order and Quietness in his Ordinary or house of Entertainment contrary to the true Intent and Meaning of the Act of Assembly in such Case provided &c.

John Blair an Orphan above the Age of fourteen years came herein Court in his proper person and prays that he may be permitted to choose a Captain David Stinson of Somerset County his Guardian which is by the Court hereunto him Granted to be chosen the said John Blair present herein Court as of &c. Made Choice of the said David Stinson as his Guardian according to the said Act of Assembly in such Case provided &c. The said David Stinson is Ordered by the Court hereunto him to take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly all the Estate personal and real of the said Orphan that he shall take into his hands and possession peaceably and quietly who ever the same should be Legally Required &c.
