Whereupon your Honor has sent out the said Petitioner in his proper Person and thereupon the Petition of being Read and heard and fully understood it is considered by the Court that a Commission goe to the said Joh. Williams as by the Petition is provided and that Isaac Coulbourn, James Gunby, Abraham Bell and O. H. bridge Sheriff of Somerset County goe to be Commissioners and execute the same Commission according to Act of Assembly in such Case Provided &

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Michell the Plaintiff in his own hand and bring him before the Court at the Court of Sessions to be held at Business Lane from the third Tuesday of August next to answer unto Robert Standy of the County of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains and shall pay unto the said Robert Standy the sum of three pounds four Shillings and a penny

And thereupon the said Robert Standy against the said Michell in the plea of In Debt Michell being summoned to answer unto Robert Standy of the County of Maryland which to him he owes and unjustly detains and shall pay unto the said Robert Standy the sum of three pounds four Shillings and a penny
