William Figg is adjudged to give Special bail to the action of the Sheriff a certain John Williams of Somerset County planter present therein Court in his proper Person under the said Daniel Kinnifin and before the Court himself that he should happen that judgment in the plea of the said William Figg against the said Daniel Kinnifin or that he the said Daniel should be therein convicted that then he the said Daniel should pay and satisfy unto the P. William the judgment of the Court thereupon or Render his body in satisfaction of such judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff of the County of P. in satisfaction thereof that he the said John Williams will do the same for him &c

Whereupon the said Daniel Kinnifin put in his place Sible Dennis Court Attorney at Law against the P. William Figg of the P. plan

And thereupon at the prayer of the parties of days to them was here given until next Court to be held at Business Court on the third Tuesday of June the next following in the State that was leaving to the Parties of P. At which day here came the P. Parties by their Attorneys P. and hereupon the said William Figg complained against the P. Daniel in the plea of P. in form following - Somers P. Daniel Kinnifin late of Somerset County Planter was Attached to answer unto William Figg of the plea of trespass upon the life and limb And whereupon the said William Figg by William Hayward his Attorney complains that Whereas the said Daniel the day of June Anno Domini 1761 at Somerset County of P. was indicted unto the said William Figg in the sum of thirty pounds fifteen Shillings and four pence of Money of Maryland for the sundry articles and things in the Account books annexed mentioned and so there of indicted being the said Daniel in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the same day and year a P. at the County of P. Upon himself answered unto the said William then and there faithfully promised that he the said Daniel the sum of Money P. when he should be thereto afterwards Required unto the said William Figg well and faithfully would pay and Content Newer the life of the said Daniel his Promise and assumption of in form P. made Sible Regarding but minding and found only Intending the said William Figg in that part Craftily and Subtly to deceive and Defraud the sum of Money P. unto the said William Figg that not paid him for the same in any sort (Altho the said Daniel the same day afterwards to wit the same day and year a P. at the County of P. by the said William Figg was Required) but the same to him to pay he the said Daniel hath Refused and Still doth Refuse and Unlawfully deny Whereupon the said William Figg says he is Worn and he the sum of the value of forty pounds of Money of Maryland and thereof he brings Suit P.
