Waller Sale of Somerset County Plaintiffs if he should be found in his Bail to be held at his
Responsibility that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Brixton
from the third Tuesday of June Anno Domini 1762 Seven hundred and Sixty Two to answer unto Alexander
Stuart of Aylesbury of the County of Bucks and the same day is given to the Plaintiff Alexander here
The Plaintiff Alexander complained against the Defendant Nathaniel Waller in the plea of in fact following

Somerset to wit Nathaniel Waller Sale of Somerset County Plaintiffs was attached to answer unto Alexander
Stuart of Aylesbury of the County of Bucks and the same day is given to the Plaintiff Alexander here
That Whereas the said Nathaniel on the twentieth day of April Anno Domini 1762 Seven hundred
and Sixty Two at Somerset County of the County of Bucks was put into the hands of the Plaintiff
Shillings and eleven pence of Money of Maryland for the Duties in the Account books of the said
County of Bucks being the said Nathaniel in Execution thereof afterwards to wit the day and year
of the County of Bucks himself did appear unto the said Plaintiff Alexander then and there faithfully promised that the
said Nathaniel when he should be thereto afterwards Required unto the said Plaintiff Alexander should faithfully pay
unto the said Plaintiff Alexander the said Sum of Money of Maryland in full and satisfy the same in full and
the same day and year at the County of Bucks by the said Plaintiff Alexander Required but the same to be
pay hath refused and still doth refuse Whereupon the said Plaintiff Alexander says he is there and hath demanded
the Value of five Pounds of Money of Maryland and thereof he brings the Bill of the 17th of Decr 1762

A Copy of the foregoing Declaration was made and sent to be read in the Court of Admiralty on the 26th day of
March which day has since the Plaintiff Alexander Stuart by his Attorney and the Sheriff's Bailiffs who
now have returned that he had taken the Defendant Nathaniel Waller whose body here at the day he had brought
Answer the Plaintiff Alexander Stuart of the County of Bucks unto him Seven hundred and Sixty Two the same Sheriff's Bailiffs
that he had delivered the said Nathaniel Waller into the hands of the Plaintiff Alexander Stuart and accordingly he has
sent Alexander Stuart a Special Bail to the Justice of the Peace of Somerset County to the same Plaintiff Alexander
Stuart in the County of Bucks and the said Nathaniel Waller and the Plaintiff Alexander Stuart himself that he should
before that Judgment in the plea of the said Plaintiff Alexander Stuart against the said Nathaniel Waller
Waller - that he the said Nathaniel should be therein content that the said Nathaniel should pay
unto the Plaintiff Alexander Stuart the sum of five Pounds of Money of Maryland in full and satisfy the same in full
to the Justice of the Peace of the County of Bucks in Satisfaction thereof that he the said Alexander Stuart should take
for his own part
