The place that we are now at is at a point of woods Below where
Crouch did Live at the mouth of a small gut Between the said
and Isaac Shurman and the Tree is still Lying on the ground and was
marks to be seen on it at which place we caused a Cedar post to be set
marked with Sixteen Natches

The Deposition of John Jenkins aged forty three years or there about
Being Sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God Depoeth and
Sayeth that about Twenty two years by past he was a crossing a Long
Shore of Wicomico River and went near to where we now are and
that he Walked Some small distance from the place and met John
Crouch who asked this Depoent where he went that Crab and he made
answer by the old Cedar at the point and the said Crouch told this
Depoent that that Old Cedar was his first Boundary of his Land
and this Depoent Sayeth that the Cedar Tree was then Lying at the
Same place where it now Lyes and further saith not

The Cedar is the same that is mentioned in Theby Disharons Deposition
where the Cedar post is set up

The Deposition of Benjamin Mitchell aged forty four years or
there about Being Sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty
God Depoeth and sayeth that about nine years by past he was
Fishing at a place Called the Shad point with one Charles Hill
and they went on Shore on a point of Land or Island on the East
Side of a small Creek Called Mufley Creek and that Charles
kindled up a fire to the West of an Old Cedar Stump and while the
said Hill was kindling the fire came John Crouch to them and told
them not to kindle their fire against that stump for that Cedar stump
was his second Boundary and they moved their fire and that the said
Crouch at that time Lived on the Land Called Hogg Neck and
further saith not

The Depositions of George Sharp aged thirty one years or there about
Being Sworn on the Holy Evangelist of Almighty God Depoeth and
Sayeth that about Seven years by past he was coming down Wicomico
River with John Crouch from Joshua Posters and when they came
opart to the point or Island mentioned in Benjamin Mitchells
Deposition the said Crouch pointed to a Cedar Stump and told the
Depoent that that Stump was their second Boundary of their Land
this Depoent owing part of that Tract of Land Called Hogg
Neck at that time and further saith not

We caused the stump to be hewn and now marked with sixteen natches
