 third tuesday of November Next then and there to be condemned according to acts of assembly to y^e for y^e
 use of a certain Aaron Sterling unless y^e said Daniel Clark by himself or his Attorney shall appear
 answer unto y^e said Aaron in a plea of Trespass upon the case &c. according to Law and that by good & law
 full men of your Bailiwick you make known unto y^e person or persons in whoes hands you make y^e
 same attachments that he she or they be and appear before our Justices of our county court of Somerset to
 be held as afo^r to shew cause if any he she or they have why y^e same goods Chattels & Credits so attached in his
 her or their hands ought not to be condemned & Execution thereof had made according to acts of assembly in such
 case made and provided if to him her or them it shall seem meet and how you shall Execute this writt that
 you make known unto our said Justices at y^e day and place afo^r and have you then and there this writt
