In which day here came the parties af by their Attorneys af and hereupon the said Mills & Eden complained against the af Stephen Sank in the plea of in form following Somerset to wit Stephen Sank late of Somerset county planter was attached to answer unto James Mills John Eden of a plea of trespass upon the case and so forth. And whereupon the said James and John by Josiah Polk their Attorney complains that whereas the said Stephen on the twenty sixth day of October Anno Domini MDCC LXI at the county af was indebted unto the said James & John in the sum of nine pounds six shillings & four pence farthing current money af for the articles in the account hereto annexed mentioned and so thereof being the said Stephen in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year af at the county af upon himself did assume and to the said James & John then and there faithfully promise that he the said Stephen Sank when he should be thereto afterwards required the sum of money af to the af James & John he would faithfully pay and content. Nevertheless the said Stephen his promise and assumption af in form af made not regarding the sum of money af to the af James & John he hath not paid or them for the same in any sort contented but that to do altogether hath refused and still doth refuse altho the same to do afterward to wit the day and year af at the county af and often since that time by the said James & John required to the damage of the said James & John twenty pound current money of Maryland and thereof they bring suit &c.
