with that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises in the information aforesaid mentioned upon her imposed in
manner and form as by the information aforesaid above against her supposed and maketh oath that Daniel Long is the father
of the child for which stands informed against but has nothing to pay her Fine withal &c

Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the court fully understood it is considered by the court
here that the said Naomi Helwick for the premises and offence aforesaid in the information aforesaid be taken &c which said
Naomi Helwick present here in court in her proper person is fined for the offence aforesaid the sum of thirty shillings
current money of Maryland but for as much as the said Naomi Helwick hath not wherewithall
to pay her fine for the offence aforesaid It is considered by the court here that the said Naomi Helwick
be whipt at the public Whipping post at Princeps Am Town with thirty stripes on the bare
back well laid on until the blood appear and that the said Naomi Helwick High Sheriff of Somerset
County do thereof execute immediately And afterwards in the same Court the said Sheriff
did whipt the said Naomi Helwick with thirty stripes on the bare back well laid on until the blood appear
at the public Whipping post at Princeps Am Town with thirty stripes according to the judgment aforesaid

Gentlemen Greeting know ye that we have appointed you or any three or two of you to be our
commissioners to examine evidences on behalf of a certain John Milburn of Somerset county in Relation to the bounds
of a Tract of Land called Prices Grove or the Bounds of any other Lands on which the same may depend we therefore
require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as to you or any three or two of you shall seem convenient
you meet on the said Land of Prices Grove or any other Lands on which the bounds of the said Land may depend you first
having taken your Oaths on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God their cause to come before you or any three or two
of you all such evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you nominated by the said Complainant or
defendant & that you or any three or two of you examine them upon their Oaths to be by you or any three
or two of you administered on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God in the presents of the complainant or defendant
touching the truth or Remembrance of their Knowledge or anything that may relate to the cause aforesaid that reducing the
several Depositions into writing you send the same with this our commission under your or any three or two of your
hands & seals to us to our county court of Somerset with all convenient speed Witness my hand & Seal this 20th day of August
in the 12th Year of our Dominion &c Anno Domini 1762

And now to wit at a court of his Lordship held at Princeps Am Town the third Tuesday of November being the 10th day of the same
month Anno Domini 1762 before the Justices thereof came Elias White and Teague Riggan two of the Gentlemen nominated
in the within commission and returned the same endorsed in manner following with the several Depositions thereto annexed
September 27 1762 Then personally came before me Samuel Addams one of his Lordships Justices of the peace in and
for the county of Somerset the within named Elias White and Teague Riggan and was qualified to execute the within
commission according to an act of assembly in such cases lately made and provided Samuel Addams
Somerset county to wit Depositions of Witnesses taken by us the subscribers the 21st Day of October Anno Domini 1762 on a

Tract of Land called Prices Grove being part of the said Tract of Land in Possession of John Milburn, as follows
Somerset county to wit the deposition of Caleb Milburn son aged fifty and five years or thereabouts deposed and said
that about thirty six years past a certain John Brittingham Senr informed this deponent that he was a chain carrier at
the Surveying of a certain Tract of Land called Prices Grove when in dispute between Ralph Milburn Senr and Samuel Collins
Senr and that there was at that time when the aforesaid John Brittingham was chain carrier a Jury of twelve men Sheriff and county
surveyor laying off the said Land called Prices Grove and the said John Brittingham informed this deponent that upon the end of a piece
of high Land near the marsh the said Jury ordered a post to be set down as a third boundary of the said Land called Prices Grove and this deponent for
his oath that upon the said point of high Land near the Marsh he the said deponent saw an oak marked with sixteen notches and has
