And Whereupon at the prayer of the parties aforesaid Day is given now here given untill Next Court to be
held at Prince's Ann Town the third Tuesday of June then next following in the state that now serv-
ing to the parties aforesaid At which day here come the parties by their attorneys and hereupon
on the aforesaid John Elliott complained against the aforesaid John Records in the plea aforesaid in form following —
Somerset vs John Records late of Somerset County planter and Jacob Scott late of Somerset County Planter

Delivered at the said Elliott's Landing at or before the Next day of March Next ensuing the date
hereof which said Parcels of Things are of the Value of Seven pounds and ten shillings Current
Money of Maryland as by the writing aforesaid fully appearth yet the said John Records and Jacob Scott
the aforesaid Cypress Boards aforesaid of Length Breadth and thickness aforesaid which are of the Value aforesaid unto
the said Elliott at or before the first day of March Next following the Date of the writing aforesaid or at any
time since at the aforesaid Elliott's Landing hath not Delivered nor paid and so the said John Elliott says
that the aforesaid John Records and the said Jacob their covenant aforesaid with him the said Elliott in his
behalf made hath not performed to him but broke and hath altogether denied and still doth
Deny to perform it to him to the Damage of the said Elliott Twenty pounds Current money of Mary-
land and thereof he brings his Suit by pleader &c Pro & Revo
And Whereupon the aforesaid John Records by his Attorney aforesaid comes and defend the force and injury when bring
prays leave therefore to Imparle Here untill Next Court to be held at Prince's Ann Town the third Tuesday
day of August then Next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Elliott here also &c
At which day here come the parties aforesaid by their Attorneys aforesaid and hereupon the aforesaid John Records prays further

ber then next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid John Elliott here also &c
At which day here come as well the aforesaid John Elliott as the aforesaid John Records by their Attorneys aforesaid and hereupon
on the aforesaid John Records prays further Leave therefore to Imparle Here untill Next Court to be held at Prince's
Ann Town the third Tuesday of March then Next following and he hath it and the same day is given to the
aforesaid John Elliott here also &c
