for the offence of above mentioned be taken &c. Which said Robert Parsons present here in court as aforesaid is fined for the offence of the sum of thirty shillings tenn money which he paid to the sheriff for the use of the county &c. Whereupon the said Robert Parsons is ordered to give security to save and keep indemnified the Justices of Somerset County Court from all costs charges troubles which might accrue by means of the birth of the Bastard Child &c. Thereupon a certain Nathan Culver present here in court in his proper person acknowledged himself to be held & firmly bound unto his Lordship the Lord property in thirty pounds tenn money of Maryland of his body goods and Chables Lands and Tenements to be made and levied to the use of his Lordship his heirs & successors if it happen that Robert Parsons do not save and keep indemnified the Justices of Somerset County Court from all costs charges troubles which may accrue by means of the birth of the Bastard Child &c.

The same Somerset to wit the Jurors for his Lordship the Right Honorable Lord property that now is the Robert Hopkins body of Somerset County upon their Oath present that Robert Hopkins late of Somerset parish in the County of on the XX Day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred sixty and two with force arms at the parish of in the County of in and upon a certain William Nutter in the peace of God and the said Lord property then and there being an assault did make and him the said William then and there did beat wound and Ill Treat so that of his life it was much dispaired and other harms to him the said William then and there did to the great Damage of the said William against the peace of his Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord property that now is and his good Rule and Government. and so forth Thereupon it is commanded the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Robert Hopkins to answer &c. And now to wit at a court of his Lordship the Lord property held at princeps Ann Town the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini 1763 came the said Robert Hopkins in his proper person had a hearing of the Indictment saith that he will not contend with his Lordship but for the saving costs Troubles Expenses about the premises submits himself at Fine with his said Lordship & puts himself upon Favours of the court &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen by the court fully understood it is considered that the said Robert Hopkins for the offence of above mentioned be taken &c. Which said Robert present here in court as aforesaid is fined the sum of one shilling tenn money which he paid to the sheriff for the use of his Lordship &c.

The same Somerset to wit Be it Remembered that George Hay ward Gent Attorney of the Right Honorable the Lord Eunice Alpha property that now is who for the same Lord property in this part presented doth come here into the Court of the same Lord property held for Somerset County to wit at princeps Ann Town in the same County before Sampson Wheatley and others his Associates the said Lord property his Justices of the same County Court and for the same Lord property doth give the same Justices here to understand and be informed that Eunice Alpha late of the parcy parish in the County of Spinston the XXX Day of Jany in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred sixty two at the parish of in the County of did Commit Fornication with a certain Person unknown and did permit the same unknown person to have carnal Knowledge of her body and a bastard Child on the body of her the said Eunice then there beget to the High displeasure of Almighty God to the Evil Example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord property that now his good rule and Government against the Form of the act of assembly in such case made and provided and so forth And Whereupon the same Attorney of the same Lord property for the same Lord property prays advice of the Court here in the premises and that due process of Law in this part may be made against the said Eunice to answer of and upon the premises and so forth. Thereupon it is commanded the sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Eunice Alpha to answer &c. And now to wit at a court of his Lordship held at princeps Ann Town the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini 1763 came the said Eunice Alpha in her proper person and had a hearing of the Information aforesaid that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises in the Information of above upon
