Ordered that Edward Waters Jun^r Recover against Thomas Jones seventy two pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances three days as an evidences on behalf of the said Thomas against Edmund Willis he having made oath to the same &

Ordered that George Sharp Recover against Signey Brown seventy two pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances three days as an evidences on behalf of the said Signey at Suit of John Weatherly James Trehearn he having made oath to the same &

Ordered that William Heath Recover against William Figgs ninety six pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances four days as an evidences on behalf of the said William against Miles Moore he having made oath to the same &

Ordered that William Nath Recover against Martha Mungao ninety six pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances four days as an evidences on behalf of his lordship against the said Martha he having made oath to the same &

Ordered that Isaac Cooper Archibald Hust & David Cordry Recover against James Must one hundred & forty four pounds of Tobacco each being due unto them for their attendances six days each as evidences on behalf of the said James against John Henry they having made oath to the same &

Ordered that Isaac Covington Recover against James Must one hundred & twenty pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances five days as an evidences on behalf of the said James against John Henry he having made oath to the same &

Ordered that William Keith & Thomas Ralph Recover against William Kinney one hundred & twenty pounds of Tobacco each being due unto them for their attendances five days each as evidences on behalf of his lordship against the said William they having made oath to the same &

Ordered that Thomas Collins Recover against John Mitchel forty eight pounds of Tobacco being due unto him for his attendances two days as an evidences on behalf of the said John against Isaac Daffheill he having made oath to the same &

Whereupon came here into Court as well the aforesaid Randal Wright as the aforesaid Robert Geddes in their proper persons & thereupon the petition aforesaid being read & heard & fully understood as likewise the severall Allegations of both parties (after mature deliberation) it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Randal Wright be discharged from his Service as by the petition aforesaid in prayd &

Thereupon it is considered by the Court now here that the aforesaid Randal Wright Recover against the aforesaid Robert Geddes his costs & charges by him in obtaining his discharge from his Service aforesaid sustained &
