

Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should summon the aff' Rencher Roberts & Mary his wife if they should be found in his bailewick that all Excuses set apart they should be and appear before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset now sitting at Prince's Town this instant March to answer unto the petition aforesaid  
And afterwards in the same Court came the aforesaid petitioners in their proper persons the Sheriff to wit Ephraim Wilson now here returned that he had summoned the aff' Rencher Roberts & Mary his wife to answer unto the petition aforesaid as to him it was commanded

Whereupon the said Gowan Right and Francis White came hancourt in their proper Persons and the aff' Rencher Roberts and Mary Roberts at the solemnly called Court in the aforesaid County and heard and fully understood it is considered that the aforesaid Gowan Right and Francis White gave bond according to Act of Assembly for the sum of one hundred pounds to be paid

Thereupon the said Gowan Right and Francis White together with William Hayward Nahamiah Brown their Servants all present herein Court in their proper Persons accordingly themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary of Maryland in the sum of five hundred Pounds Current Money of Maryland of their Bodys Goods or Chattels Lands and Tenements jointly and severally to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors to be made and Lived if it happen that the said Gowan Right and Francis White do not deliver up and make payment of all Goods and Chattels which shall come to their hands and possession by virtue of or under such Order as the Justice of the County Court aforesaid shall make in Relation to the delivering up of the Estate of the aforesaid Matthew Wallace to the said Gowan and Francis according the full Value of the said Goods and Chattels as the Law of this Province Requires to any Person or Persons who have a Right to demand the same when they shall be demanded Required to Thereupon it is Ordered by the Court that the aff' Rencher Roberts and Mary Roberts deliver up unto the aforesaid Gowan Right and Francis White all the Estate heretofore the aforesaid Matthew Wallace as Debts upon the Administration of the Estate a Captain Matthew Wallace deceased

John Baker Appointed Standard keeper for Somerset County by giving Security according to Act of Assembly in such Proportion as thereon the said John Baker with William Hayward and Isaac Fullerton of Somerset County Planters his Security all present herein Court in their proper Persons acknowledged themselves indebted to his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in fifty Pounds Sterling Money of Great Britain of their Bodys Goods or Chattels Lands and Tenements jointly and severally to the use of his said Lordship taken and Lived if it happen that the said John Baker do not pay the Standard of Somerset County due to his aforesaid Master and Mazzor as he shall Receive into his hands and possession and the same Redeliver when that Legally Required to Ordered the 1<sup>st</sup> of January 1763 delivered up unto John Baker Standard keeper of the said County and having Wright and Measures belonging to Somerset County

On the 20<sup>th</sup> Day of December 1762 came Mr Thomas Hollbrooke of Somerset and made Oath that he would well and truly serve his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the office of Deputy Commissioner of Somerset County that he will do Equal Right to the poor and to the Rich so far as man has said Office and according to the Laws and Presidents of this Province that he will not delay nor hinder right nor Justice to anyone in his said Office that he will increase no fees but be content with the Fees limited by Law and in all things well and truly behave himself in his aforesaid Office to his Lordship and all persons concerned therewith according to the Best of his Skill and Knowledge until he shall be lawfully discharged thereof
