Whereupon the said John Records at the prayer of the a<sup>d</sup> Michael Thay. is adjudged to give special  
Bail to the Action of Plaintiff but for want thereof the said John Records is committed to the prison  
of the Sheriff of the County a<sup>d</sup> Michael Thay.

And the a<sup>d</sup> John Records in his proper person in court a<sup>d</sup> Michael Thay. doth saye that he doth  
when he and saith that he cannot deny the action a<sup>d</sup> Michael Thay. and that he doth  
affirm upon himself in manner and form a<sup>d</sup> the a<sup>d</sup> Michael above against him hath complained and  
at the damage of the said Michael by him by occasion of the same for the said John saith and  
acknowledgeth that the a<sup>d</sup> Michael hath sustained damage by occasion of the same for beyond  
his cost and charges by him about his suit in that part appeared to Nine pounds five shillings and  
pence current money and more and because the a<sup>d</sup> John doth not but the said allegation  
goeth to be true doth a<sup>d</sup> Michael by reason of those damages above abovesaid together with his cost and  
charges a<sup>d</sup> him to be adjuged t<sup>e</sup> therefor by consent of the parties a<sup>d</sup> it is agreed that  
the a<sup>d</sup> Michael Thay. recover against the a<sup>d</sup> John Records his damages a<sup>d</sup> the a<sup>d</sup> N.<sup>t</sup>  
Pounds five shillings and Ten pence current money by the same John in full satisfaction of all  
bounds, costs, charges for his cost and charges to the same Michael  
as he required by the court now here of the affiant for the justice of which claim damages  
the whole amount to Nine pounds five shillings and Ten pence current money and  
Bairm of Shays a<sup>d</sup> the a<sup>d</sup> Michael in money a<sup>d</sup>

a<sup>d</sup> Shiles Moore a<sup>d</sup> command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John  
Records a<sup>d</sup> second Esq<sup>r</sup> of Somerset County Planter if he should be found in his bailiwick  
and him should safe keep that he might have his body before the Justices of  
his Lordships county Court of Somerset to be held at Prince of Ann from the third Tuesday of March  
Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and sixty three to answer unto Shiles Moore of a place of  
frogs upon the case. The same day is given to the a<sup>d</sup> Shiles Moore to  
All which day here arms the a<sup>d</sup> Shiles Moore by Welsh Park his Attorney and the Sheriff to wit  
John Wilson now here returned that he had taken the a<sup>d</sup> John Records whose body he had at  
this day he had ready to answer the a<sup>d</sup> Shiles Moore of Shays place to him it was commanded a<sup>d</sup> him  
Whereupon the said Shiles Moore complained against the a<sup>d</sup> John Records in the place a<sup>d</sup> in  
form following — Somerset John Records late of Somerset County Planter was attached

to answer unto Shiles Moore of a place of Frogs upon the case a<sup>d</sup>

And whereupon the said Shiles by Welsh Park his Attorney complains that whereas the said  
John on the eighteenth day of December anno Domini MDCCLXI at the county a<sup>d</sup> paid and deliv-  
ered unto the said Shiles in the sum of thirtynine pounds seven shillings and four pence  
current money of Maryland for the articles in the account hereto annexed mentioned and is  
thereof indebted being the said John in consideration thereof afterward to wit the day and  
year a<sup>d</sup> at the county a<sup>d</sup> upon himself did assume and to the said Shiles then and there faithfully  
promised that he the said John when he should be thereto afterwards required the sum of  
money a<sup>d</sup> to the a<sup>d</sup> Shiles he would faithfully pay and content. Nevertheless the said John  
his promise and assumption a<sup>d</sup> in form a<sup>d</sup> made not regarding the sum of money a<sup>d</sup> to the  
a<sup>d</sup> Shiles he hath not paid him for the same in any sort contented but that to do altogether  
he hath refused and still doth refuse altho the same to do afterwards to wit the day and year a<sup>d</sup> at  
the county a<sup>d</sup> and often since that time by the said Shiles required to the damage of the said  
Shiles sixty pounds current money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit to a<sup>d</sup> pledgee I doe & a<sup>d</sup> Rose
