

Whereupon the said John Records at the prayer of the said Michael Thayer is adjudged to give special Bail to the action of the said Thayer but for want thereof the said John Records is committed to the prison of the Sheriff of the County of Somerset

And the said John Records in his proper person in County of Somerset doth confess the fact and injury when he said that he cannot deny the action of the said John Michael Thayer nor that he doth assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Michael above against him hath explained and avers to the damage of the said Michael by him by Decision of the Brevisors the said John Records doth acknowledge that the said Michael hath sustained Damages by Decision of the Brevisors beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part Appoyed to Nine pound five Shillings and Ten pence Current Money and not more and because the said John Records hath not the said Damages granted to be his Oath Judgment for those Damages above Acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges of the same to be adjudged & therefore by Consent of the Justice of the Peace it is considered that

The said Michael Thayer recover against the said John Records his Damages of the said Brevisors the said five Shillings and Ten pence Current Money by the same John Records in form of Plea and Judgment as above and the said John Records for his Costs and Charges to the said Michael Records of the same to be adjudged & the whole amount to Nine pound five Shillings and Ten pence Current Money and the said Michael in Money & Damages of the same to be adjudged & the said Michael in Money &

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take John Shiles Moore and him should safe keep what he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships county Court of Somerset to be hold at Princeps Ann's town the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini the ninth seven hundred and sixty three to answer unto Shiles Moore of a plea of Trespass upon the case &c. the same day is given to the said Shiles Moore at which Day here comes the said Shiles Moore by his Attorney and the Sheriff to wit John Raines now here returned that he had taken the said John Records whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the said Shiles Moore of the said plea as to him it was commanded & whereupon the said Shiles Moore complained against the said John Records in the plea of in form following - Somersets John Records late of Somerset County Plaintiff was attached to answer unto Shiles Moore of a plea of Trespass upon the case &c. And whereupon the said Shiles Moore by his Attorney complains that whereas the said John on the eighteenth day of December Anno Domini 1761 at the County of Somerset was attached unto the said Shiles Moore in the sum of thirty two pounds seven shillings and four pence Current Money of Maryland for the articles in the account hereto annexed mentioned and thereof indebted being the said John in consideration thereof afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County of Somerset upon himself did assume and to the said Shiles Moore then and there faithfully promised that he the said John when he should be thereto afterwards required the sum of money aforesaid to the said Shiles Moore he would faithfully pay and content. Nevertheless the said John his promise and assumption aforesaid in form aforesaid made not regarding the sum of money aforesaid to the said Shiles Moore he hath not paid nor him for the same in any sort contented but that to do altogether hath refused and still doth refuse altho the same to do afterwards to wit the day and year aforesaid at the County of Somerset and often since that time by the said Shiles Moore required to the damage of the said Shiles Moore sixty pounds Current Money of Maryland and thereof he brings Suit & pledges to Doe & Roe
