 ships Justices of the peace for the county of Down and
 made oath on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God that
 the above acct. is just and true, that he hath not received
 any part nor parcel nor security or satisfaction more than
 credit given to the best of his knowledge soon before Mr. James
 Whorson the said John Records at the prayer of the ap.
 Shiles Moor is adjudged to give special bail to the action ap.
 but for want thereof the said John Records is committed to the
 prison of the sheriff of the county ap. there to remain.

And the ap. John Records in his proper person in
 custody ap. comes and defends the force and injurgation &
 avers that he cannot deny the action ap. of the ap.
 Shiles Moor nor but that he did abjure upon himself in
 manner and form as the ap. Shiles above against him
 hath complained and as to the damage of the said Shiles
 by occasion of the premises the said John saith and
 acknowledged that the ap. Shiles hath sustained damage
 by him by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and
 charges by him about his suit in that part sustained

Money and not more and because the ap. Shiles denies not this but the same Allegation granted to be true
 pray Judgment for these damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges ap. to him to be
 adjudged - Therefore by consent of the parties ap. it is considered that the ap. Shiles Moor recover
 against the ap. John Records his damages ap. to the ap. Eleven pounds ten shillings and two pence current
 Money by the same John in form ap. acknowledged as also
 pounds of Tobacco for his costs and charges to the same Shiles at his request by the court now here
