Bondy, John Pidout Charles Goldborough William Hayward Langman Wheately - Joseph Gillis Samuel Adams William Winder Ephraim Wilson Ephraim Key - Thomas Jones, John Dennis Thomas Hoblouck, Lazarus Williams, William Adams - David Polk Thomas Moore and Jacob Tilman or any three or more of you asaf to you out Writs Except Procesp and Attachment and hold pleasall Actions popular and all Actions Personall of whatever Lawes wherein the same and Deth not exceed the sum of One hundred Pounds Sterling or thirty thousand pounds of tobacco and all Actions personall now depending before you and after Judgment Execution to be done in all such Cases and Actions as According to the Laws Customs and Directions of the Act of Assembly as before forth as they provide and where they are silent According to the Laws Statutes and Reasonable Customs of England as used and Practised within this Province in which said Actions shall be tried we do - constitute Ordain and appoint you the said Benjamin Taylor, Charles Hammond, Samuel Chamberlain Edward Layd Richard Lee Benedict Elvert Robert Jenkins Henry Daniel Dulany Stephen W. Bondy John Pidout Charles Goldborough William Hayward Langman Wheately, Joseph Gillis Samuel Adams William Winder Ephraim Wilson Ephraim Key Thomas Jones, John Dennis Thomas Hoblouck Lazarus Williams, William Adams David Polk Thomas Moore and Jacob Tilman and none others to be Judges Alſo by these Presents we do Command and the Sheriff of our said County of Somerset that at the several Courts to be held from time to time he give his Attendance and cause to come before you or any three or more of you in said County he also his Attendant and Cause to come before you or any three or more of you as if such and so many good and lawfull men of his Parish were out of each and every hundred thereof by whom the truth of the Matter in the Premises may be the better known and examined of lastly you shall cause to be brought before you at your said Court all Writs Procesp and Judgments to you Courts and jurisdiction belonging that the same may be inspected and by due Course of Law determined Witnesſe Our Treaty and well beloved Friends.
