Leonard Jones Center an Orphan of his Own free Consent is bound out by the Court here an Apprentices according to Act of Assembly in such Case Provided unto James Brown of Somerset County Ship Carpenter until he the said Leonard Jones Center should arrive at the Age of Twenty One Years the said Leonard Jones Center to have his said Master the full Term of Years during which term the said Apprentices his said Master well and faithfully he shall serve his secrets keep his Commandments Lawfully and honestly buy where willingly he shall see and in all things as a good and faithfull Apprentice he shall demean himself towards his said Master and In Consideration of which Service the said James Brown present herein Court in his proper person Cometh with the Justice of the said Court in Court Judicially sitting in Manner and form following that is to say that he the said Leonard Jones Center shall and will during the term of Years his said Apprentices the Trade of a Ship Carpenter and to Read write and Cypher as far as the Single Rule of three Inclusive and at the Expiration of his said Trade give him a Broad Lay and hand saw and a new Suit of Cloaths of Narrow Broad Cloth Over and Above his Common wearing Cloaths and likewise find and provide for his said Apprentices Meat Drink Washing Dyeing and Clothing sufficient for such an Apprentices to have and wear during the term of Years

Whereupon the said James Brown is bound to Give Security to Comply with the Covenants of his Security all present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves indebted unto the said Leonard Jones Center in the Sum of thirty Pounds Current Money of Maryland of their Obedience and Fealty jointly and Severally to the Use of the said Leonard Jones Center his heirs and Assigns to be made and Levied if it happen that the said James Brown do not during the term of Years his said Apprentices the Trade of a Ship Carpenter and to Read Write and Cypher as far as the Single Rule of three Inclusive and at the Expiration of his said Trade do not Give him a Broad Lay and hand saw and a new Suit of Cloaths of Narrow Broad Cloth Over and Above his Common wearing Cloaths and do not Likewise find and provide for his said Apprentices Meat Drink Washing Dyeing and Clothing sufficient for such an Apprentices to have and wear during the term of Years

George Full an Orphan Above the Age of fourteen Years came herinto Court in his proper person to the Court and Prays that he may be permitted to have a Guardian John Dallet of Somerset County as his Guardian which is by the Court hereunto him Granted Whereupon the said George Full present herein Court as made Choice of the said John Dallet as his Guardian Accordingly Whereupon the said John Dallet is bound by the Court here to take into his Care and possession the said George Full Orphan of and all his Estate Real and Personal and that the said Guardian Give Good Security to Comply with the Law in Relation to the Guardianship of and to deliver up unto the said Orphan his heirs or Assigns all his Estate Real and Personal that he shall take into his hands and possession peaceably and Quietly whenever the same should be Legally Required

Whereupon the said John Dallet together with Edler Dennis and Joshua Manill of Somerset County Gentlemen his Securitys all present herein Court in their proper persons Acknowledge themselves indebted unto the said George Full in two hundred pounds Current Money of Maryland of their Obedience and Fealty jointly and Severally to the Use of the said George Full his heirs or Assigns to be made and Levied if it happen that the said John Dallet Guardian of the said George Full do not Comply with the Law in Relation to such Guardianship of and do not Deliver up unto the said George Full his heirs or Assigns all the Estate Real and Personal of the said George Full that he shall take into his hands and possession peaceably and Quietly whenever the same should be Legally Required
