Present herein Court in his proper Person Covenanteth with the Justices of the same Court in Court -  
 Judicially sitting in Manner and form following that is to say that he the said Moses Carmain shall  
 and will during the term of <sup>3</sup> Learn his said Apprentice the trade of a Cordiner and to Read writing -  
 Ciphers as far as the Rule of Three Inclusive and at the expiration of his servitude give him a set of  
 Cordiner Tools and a New suit of Cloths of County Make over and allow his common weareing Cloth  
 and Likewise find and provide for his said Apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing -  
 Sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of <sup>3</sup>.

Whereupon the said Moses Carmain is ordered to give security to comply with the covenant  
 Whereupon the said Moses Carmain together with William Hastings and John Harten  
 of Somers County Planters his security all present herein Court in their proper persons acknowledge  
 themselves to be indebted unto the aforesaid Archibald Hastings in Thirty pounds Current money of England  
 on their Goods & Chattels Lands and tenement jointly and severally to the use of the said -  
 Archibald Hastings his heirs and Assigns to be made and levied if it happen that the said Moses -  
 Carmain do not during the term of <sup>3</sup> Learn his said Apprentice the trade of a Cordiner and to Read -  
 Ciphers as far as the Rule of Three Inclusive and at the expiration of his servitude do not give  
 him a set of Cordiner tools and a new suit of Cloths Over and allow his common weareing Cloth  
 and Likewise find and provide for his said Apprentice meat drink washing Lodging and Clothing -  
 Sufficient for such an Apprentice to have and wear during the term of <sup>3</sup>.

Ioh. White To the Worshipfull Justices of Somers County in Court sitting the petition of John White -  
 Pet. { of Danes Quaker Humbly sheweth that he has a right to the half of two tract of Land the  
 one <sup>1/2</sup> fathers and sons desire and the other called friends contention and the other half of the above

 Drove the Bounds of the said two tract and your petitioners will ever pray - Ioh. White

Whereupon came hereinto Court the aforesaid Petitioners in their proper persons and thereupon the petition  
 being Read and heard and fully understood it is considered by the Court here that a Commission be given  
 to the aforesaid Ioh. White as by the petition of <sup>1/2</sup> is proved and that Jas. Darrell George Irving Thom  
 son and Robert Gray of Somers County be Commissioners and sent to the same Commission according  
 to Act of Assembly in such Case provided <sup>3</sup>
