Moses here in court produced the date is the day and year as promised & obliged themselves to pay
unto the said Outerbridge the sum of seven pounds ten shillings and ten pence with lawfull Interest
on or before the first day of December next ensuing the date of the said Bill and to the faithfull payment
thereof to be made and done by this time of they the said William Solomon Moses bound themselves in the
penal sum of fourteen pounds ten shillings and ten pence firmly by the said Bill and the said Outerbridge
in fact says that the said William Solomon Moses did not pay unto the said Outerbridge the of
sum of seven pounds ten shillings and ten pence with the lawfull Interest thereon on or before the
said first day of December next ensuing the date of the said Bill according to the form force and effect
of the said Bill by which action hath accrued to the said Outerbridge to require and have of the said
William Solomon Moses the said fourteen pounds ten shillings and ten pence to be paid unto
the said Outerbridge when they the said William Solomon Moses should be thereto after
