Never the less the said Peter his promise and undertaking do in fact do make little regarding but minding, fraudulently Intending the said George Farrington in this particular craftily, subtilly to deceive & defraud the sum of money do unto the said George hath not paid on him for the same in any sort contented (altho the same to do the same Peter afterwards to wit the same day and year last do and often since at the county do by the said George was required) but the same to him to pay hitherto altogether hath refused and still doth refuse, unjustly deny. Whereupon the said George says he is worse & hath damage to the Value of Twenty pounds Current money of Maryland, thereof he brings suit do Forth

Whereupon at the prayer of the do. George Farrington the do. Peter Magee is adjudged to give special Bail to this action do. Whereupon a certain William Giles present here in court in his proper person undertook for the said Peter Magee and assumed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgement in the plea do. should be rendered for the said George Farrington against the do. Peter Magee or that the said Peter Magee should be therein convict that then he the said Peter should pay and satisfy unto the do. George Farrington the Judgement of the court there upon or render his body in Execution of such Judgement to the prison of the Sheriff of the county do in satisfaction thereof or that he the said William Giles will do the same for him do.

Whereupon the said Peter Magee by Libbleton Dennis his Attorney comes, defends the force & Injury when it and saith that he cannot deny this action do. of the do. George Farrington nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner & form as the do. George Farrington above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same George by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same Peter Magee with and acknowledgeth that the do. George hath sustained damage by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part opposed to eight pounds Curr. Money not more and because the do. George Farrington denies not this but the same allegation grants to be true pray Judgement for these damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges do. to him to be adjudged do. Therefore by consent of the parties do. it is considered that the do. George Farrington Recover against the do. Peter Magee his Damages do. to the do. eight pounds Curr. Money by the do. Peter in form do. acknowledged as also
