George Scott here &c.

At which day here came the ap. George Scott by Littleton Dennis his Attorney the sheriff to wit John Dennis now here returned that he had taken the ap. Thomas Slop whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the ap. George Scott of the plea ap. as to him it was commanded &c.
