And Whereupon the said George by Littleton Dennis his Attorney says that whereas the said Thomas on the twenty second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred fifty and six at Somerset County aforesaid by his certain writing obligatory which the said Day Scotts in his life time with the seal of the said Thomas sealed here to the court shews whose date is the same day & year aforesaid acknowledged himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said Day Scotts in his life time in the full and just sum of fifty five pounds ten shillings and two pence current money of Maryland and the quantity of two thousand two hundred and ninety four pounds of tobacco to be paid to the said Day Scotts his certain Attorney Executors admors or assigns when he the said Thomas should be therunto required never the less the aforesaid Thomas altho often required the aforesaid sum of fifty five pounds ten shillings and two pence current money of Maryland and the quantity of two thousand two hundred and ninety four pounds of tobacco unto the aforesaid Day Scotts in his life time or unto the said George since the death of the aforesaid Day Scotts (to which the said George administration of all and singular the goods and chattels rights & Credits which were of the aforesaid Day Scotts at the time of his death by Nehemiah King Gentleman Deputy commissary of Somerset county aforesaid lawfully constituted and admitted the day of \_\_\_\_\_ in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred fifty and \_\_\_\_\_ at Somerset County aforesaid after the death of the aforesaid Day Scotts in due form of Law was committed) hath not paid but the same to the said Day Scotts in his life time and unto the said George after the death of the aforesaid Day Scotts hitherto to pay altogether hath refused and still doth refuse and unjustly detain wherefore the said George says he is wrong and hath damage to the Value of fifty five pounds ten shillings and two pence current money of Maryland and two thousand two hundred and ninety four pounds of tobacco and thereupon he brings Suit & so forth, and doth bring here into court the Letters of admors aforesaid of the Deputy Commissary aforesaid which the commissary of the admors aforesaid in sum aforesaid doth testify the date whereof is the same day & year aforesaid & so forth & \_\_\_\_\_ pledges & Doe & Drive
