himself to owe and be indebted unto the said George Dashiell in the sum of three pounds three
shillings current money of Maryland to be paid to the said George Dashiell when he the said
Thomas should be thereto afterwards required to which payment well truly to be made and
done the said Thomas firmly bound himself by the said Bill & ever the said Thomas
the often thereto required the afo. sum of three pounds three shillings current money of Maryland
the said George Dashiell hath not paid but the same to him to pay hitherto altogether hath denied
and still doth deny unjustly detain, Whereupon the said George Dashiell says he is worse hath
damages to the value of ten pounds current money of Maryland and thereof he brings suit

Whereupon at the prayer of the afo. George Dashiell the afo. Thomas Tadwain is adjudged to give
special Bail to the action afo. Thereupon a certain George Daily of Somerset County
present here in court in his proper undertook for the said Thomas Tadwain & assumed upon him-
self that if it should happen that judgement in the plea afo. should be rendered for the
said George Dashiell against the afo. Thomas Tadwain or that the said Thomas should be
therein convicted that then he the said Thomas Tadwain should pay and satisfy unto the afo.
George Dashiell the judgement of the court thereupon or render his body in execution of
such judgement to the prison of the sheriff of the County afo. in satisfaction thereof that he

And hereupon the afo. Thomas Tadwain by Samuel Wilson his Attorney comes & defends
the force injury when it says that he cannot deny the action afo. of the afo. George Dashiell
