 At which day here came the ap^t William Floyd by George Hayward his Attorney & the sheriff
 to wit Ephraim Wilson now here returned that he had taken the ap^t William Tull whose
 body here at this day he had ready to answer the ap^t William Floyd of the ap^t plea as to him
 it was commanded &c
 Whereupon the ap^t William Tull puts in his place Sibleton Dennis Gent. Attorney at
 Law against the ap^t William Floyd of the ap^t plea
 And hereupon at the prayer of the parties ap^t Day is to them now here given untill next Court
 to be held at princeps Ann Town the third Tuesday of March then next following in this
 state that now saving to the parties ap^t
 At which day here came the parties ap^t by their Attorneys ap^t and hereupon the ap^t William
 Floyd complained against the ap^t William Tull in the plea ap^t in form following
 Somersets William Tull son of Noble Late of Somerset County planter was attacked to
 answer unto William Floyd of a plea wherefore with force and arms in and upon him the
 said William Floyd an assault did make and him the said William Floyd then and
 there did beat wound and Cruelly Treat so that of his Life it was greatly impaired and
 other harms to him the said William Floyd then and there did to the great damage of the said
 William Floyd and against the peace of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord property that now is
 his good Rule and Government &c And Whereupon the said William
 Floyd by Geo. Hayward his Attorney complains that whereas the said William Tull
 the Day of in the year four Lord one thousand seven hundred sixty and
 two at the county ap^t with force and arms in and upon him the said William Floyd
 an assault did make and him the said William Floyd then and there did beat wound
 and Cruelly Treat so that of his Life it was greatly impaired and other harms to him the
 said William Floyd then and there did to the great damage of the said William Floyd
 and against the peace of his Lordship the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord property that now is his
 good rule and Government &c so forth to the damage of the said William Floyd Fifty
 pounds current Money of Maryland and thereof he brings Suit &c
 And the ap^t William Tull by his Attorney ap^t Doe & Roe pledges &c
 comes and defends the force and injury when &c and prays leave thereof to Impeach
 here untill next Court to be held at princeps Ann Town the third Tuesday of June then
 next following &c he hath it and the same day is given to the ap^t William Floyd here also &c
 At which day here came as well the ap^t William Floyd as the ap^t William Tull by
 their Attorneys ap^t and hereupon the ap^t William Tull as before defends the force and injury
 when &c and saith that he cannot deny the action ap^t of the ap^t William Tull nor but
 that he is guilty of the premises in manner and form as the ap^t William Floyd above
 against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same William Floyd by him by occasion of the premises in that
 part sustained the same William Tull hath acknowledged that the ap^t William Floyd hath sustained damages
 by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part assessed to one penny
 current Money and not more and because the ap^t William Floyd denies not this but the same allegation grants
 to be true prays Judgement for these damages above acknowledged together with his costs & charges to him to be adjudged &c
 Therefore by consent of the parties ap^t it is considered that the ap^t William Floyd recover against the ap^t William Tull
 his damages ap^t to the ap^t one penny current Money by the ap^t William Tull in form of acknowledged as also
 pounds of Tobacco for his costs and charges ap^t To the same to the same William
 Floyd at his request by the court now here of the ap^t of the parties ap^t adjudged which contain damages in the whole amount
 to one penny current Money and pounds of Tobacco and the ap^t William Tull in mercy &c

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
