David Polk aged fifty six years or thereabouts being Sworn saith about eight or Ten years agoe he was at the setting up of a leaden post as a boulder of W^m Disharcones Land and that John Christopher Sen^r was present and said that was the place where John Fuzels boulder formerly stood and that it was a pine that he was not at the marking the boulder but saw it soon after that some person told him the said Christopher that it was the boulder of Fuzels Land and John Mears being presents said no the boulder says Mears is an oak, it is a Lye says J. Christopher the boulder is a pine and further saith not

John Disharconne aged fifty two years being Sworn saith that he was present at the setting up of the leaden post afores. and John Christopher being there said that the boulder of John Fuzels Land stood where they were going to set up the said post and that it was a pine for his father had told him soe and John Mears being there contradicted Christopher you are a Lye says Christopher the boulder was a pine Tree and further saith not

any three or two of you all such evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you nomi-
nated by the said complainant or def^t that you or any three or two of you examine them
upon their corporall oaths to be by you or any three or two of you administered on the Holy
Evangelist of Almighty God in the presence of the complainant or Def^t if any touching
the truth or Remembrance of their knowledg or anything that may relate to the cause
aforesaid that reducing the several depositions into writing you send the same with this
our commission under your or any three or two of your hands and seals to us to our county
court of Somerset with all convenient speed Witness Isaac Handy Esq^r Chief Justice of
our said court y^e 21st day of Dec^r in the 11 year of our Dominion &c Anno Domⁱ 1761

of June being the twenty first day of the same Month Anno Domⁱ one thousand seven hundred
and sixty three before the Justices thereof came Abraham Outen and Purnell Culen two of the
