And now to wit at a court of his Lordship held at princess Ann Town the third tuesday of June being the twenty first day of the name Month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and sixty three before the Justices thereof came George Gale and Thomas Irving two of the Gentlemen Nominated in the within commission and returned the same endorsed in manner following with the following deposition thereto annexed
July 1st 1762 Then was the within mentioned Thomas Irving & George Gale sworn on the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God to execute the within commission. Ephraim King March 16th 1763 We the subscribers do hereby certify that being Qualifyd to execute the within commission we did on the 11th day of August meet on the Land called Barlers Nest & did take the deposition here to annexed after having given publick notice according to the act of assembly for that purpose Willm. our hand & seals William Giles about fifty six years of age being sworn on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God on the eleventh day of August Anno Domini 1763 Thos. Irving & Thos. Gale Sealed seventeen hundred and sixty two deparst that about forty years ago his father shewed him a pine (the stump of which we are now at) and told him it was the third bounder of James Hardys Land & further with not — Wm. Giles The tree above mentioned is gone except a small part of the stump and there is at the place fixed there by the commissioners a Sash post marked with sixteen Notches
