Frederick Absolute Lord and Bishop of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore &c To the Justices & Clerk of Somerset County greeting we being willing for a certain Cause that the Record Proceedings of a certain Warrant or Indictment before you depending against Nathaniel Whitaker of Somerset County Clerk should be certified to you as Justices of our Provincial Court at the City of Annapolis we Command you that the aforesaid Proceedings with every thing thereto relating as full and entire in as ample manner form as they remain before you by you to discover name and addition the said Nathaniel Whitaker be Reported ye have before of Justices of our Provincial Court to be held at Annapolis the second Tuesday of September next under your hands and you send together with this writ that our same Justices may further do therein that which of Right they see ought to be done Witness John Spive Esq: Chief Justice of our said Provincial Court the 10th Day of April in the 11th Year of our Dominion Anno Domini 1760
