called Stephen Bloyd of Somerset County if they should be found in y<sup>e</sup> County with them  
I should safe keep so that he might have these w<sup>ch</sup> before the Justice of his Lordships Court by law  
of Somerset to be held at Buxton Ann Towne y<sup>e</sup> third Tuesday of June Anno Domini 1758  
seven hundred & sixty to answer unto Mitchell Barrister of a plea that they render unto  
him the sum of fifteen pounds Current money of Virginia of y<sup>e</sup> Value of Twenty Pounds Current  
Money of Maryland which from him they unjustly Detain and Defult

And the same day is given to the Mitchell Barrister here  
At which day here came the s<sup>r</sup> Mitchell Barrister by Samuel Wilson his att<sup>y</sup>  
Another Sheriff to wit, John Dennis Gentleman now here returned that he had taken  
The s<sup>r</sup> Samuel Hensley whose body he at this day he had ready to answer y<sup>e</sup>  
of said Mitchell Barrister of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>r</sup> Buxton to him it was commanded & further  
of same Sheriff returned that the s<sup>r</sup> Stephen Bloyd could not be found in his County  
with

Whereupon the said Samuel Hensley at y<sup>e</sup> Buxton y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Mitchell  
Barrister is Adjudged to give special Bail to y<sup>e</sup> Action of said Sheriff upon a certain  
Stephen Hensley of Somerset County Planter Current here in Court in his proper  
Person undertake for y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Hensley that if it should happen that judgment  
in y<sup>e</sup> plea of said should be rendered for y<sup>e</sup> said Mitchell Barrister against the s<sup>r</sup>  
Samuel Hensley or that the s<sup>r</sup> said Samuel Hensley should be therein convicted that then  
the said Samuel should pay & satisfy unto y<sup>e</sup> said Mitchell the judgment  
of y<sup>e</sup> Court thereupon or tender his body in Execution of such judgment to the  
Custody of y<sup>e</sup> Sheriff of y<sup>e</sup> County of y<sup>e</sup> in Satisfaction thereof or that he the s<sup>r</sup>  
Stephen Hensley will do & save for him y<sup>e</sup>

Whereupon the said Samuel Hensley puts in his place David Wilson Gentleman Attorney at Law  
against the aforesaid Mitchell Barrister in the aforesaid plea  
And thereupon at y<sup>e</sup> Buxton of y<sup>e</sup> Buxton of aforesaid day is to them here now given until next  
Court to be held at Buxton Ann Towne the third Tuesday of August then next following in y<sup>e</sup>  
State that now saving to y<sup>e</sup> Parties aforesaid

At which day here came the Parties aforesaid by their att<sup>y</sup> aforesaid and hereupon y<sup>e</sup> said  
Mitchell Barrister Dulcific against the aforesaid Samuel in y<sup>e</sup> plea of y<sup>e</sup> sum of
