At which day said Samuel and Stephen & Mitchell & Barrister in Law of said County by their Attorneys appearing in person of Samuel as before Responds the said and Jurors returned and saith that he cannot deny the Return of of the said Mitchell nor that the Writing Obligatory aforesaid is of Debt of him of said Samuel nor that he owes of said Mitchell to a certain the sum of fifteen pounds Virginia Money of value of Twenty pounds current Money of Maryland in manner and form as of aforesaid Mitchell above against him hath Declared Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid Mitchell Barrister recover Against the aforesaid Samuel & Stephen his Debt aforesaid & his Damages by Reason of of Detention of that said Debt to be found of said Mitchell of his Assent by of Court here adjudged And of aforesaid Samuel & Stephen Merit &c
