And do not answer unto his said Lordships of and concerning the Judgment of Francis  
Not stand, abide of Judgment of the Court there and do not Depart the same Court  
Without leave and in meantime if he said John Donchoe be of good behavior  
Thereupon it was Commaned by the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should leave to  
Come before his said Lordships Justice at next Court to be held at Bincus Arm Town  
The third Tuesday of August then next following Twelve good and Lawfull men of his  
County with whom of truth of the Sumpter's may be better known and who are no  
Affinity to the said John Donchoe to Agree upon their Oath of the said John Donchoe  
be guilty of the Sumpter's or not because as well as of William Hayward Gent  
his Lordships Attorney who for his said Lordships in this part Prosecute and  
Upon said John Donchoe have put themselves upon that Jury

At which said third Tuesday of August came as well as of William Hayward Gent his Counsel  
Attorney who for his said Lordships in this part Prosecute in the name of John Donchoe in his  
Prosecution according to his Recognizance by him & his Oath in that part before acknowledged  
And the Sheriff John Dennis Esquire Sheriff of the County of Somerset returned the Oath of the Jurors  
and the names of the Jurors in all things demanded and executed and the Jurors of that Jury there of  
Impannelled being called to wit, William Shiver, Spencer Harris, Mafsey Dearham, Wm  
Marwick, David Wilson, Isaac Boulton, Joseph Scroggin, Jeph Dashiell, Isaac Althinson, Mith  
Norman, Charles Scathbury and Haug Miles, being called came to say the truth of their  
Sumpter's being tried, Swore upon their Oath that the said John Donchoe is not  
guilty of the Sumpter's or in the Judgment of above specified in manner of James of  
John Donchoe for himself whereby his plea hath alledged upon which it is considered by  
the Court that the said John Donchoe of the Sumpter's as aforesaid in the Judgment of  
above specified be Discharged of good thereof without day
