Guilty and Lou Swall thereof puts himself upon the County and William Hayward Genl. his Lordships Atty who for his said Lordship in this part Prosecuteth in the name thereof upon the said James Rigger is ordered to Recognise with one Security in ten Counts current money for his the said James Rigger appearance at a next Court to be held at Brines Arm Town in and for the County of Somerset the third Tuesday of August then next following to answer unto his said Lordships of and concerning the Indictment aforesaid and to stand and abide the judgment of the Court & thereupon in the meantime to be of good behaviour

Thereupon the said James Rigger with William Allen of Somerset County Genl. his Security both present herein Court in their proper person acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his said Lordships in the sum of ten pounds current money of Maryland of this Nobles Goods and Chattels and Tenements jointly and severally to the use of his said Lordships his heirs & Successors to be on a day and a date if it happen that the said James Rigger do not make his personal appearance before the Justice of his said Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Brines Arm Town the third Tuesday of August then next following and do not answer unto his said Lordships of and concerning the Indictment aforesaid do not stand and abide the judgment of the Court thereupon and do not depart of the said Court without leave and in the meantime if the said James Rigger be not of good behaviour &c

Thereupon it was commanded of the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should cause to come before his Lordships Justice at a next Court to be held at Brines Arm Town the third Tuesday of August then next following twelve good and lawful men of his Bailiwick by whom the truth of the Premises may be better known and who are of no affinity to the said James Rigger to Recognise upon their Oath if the said James Rigger be guilty of the Premises or not because as well of the said William Hayward his Lordships Atty who for his said Lordships in this part Prosecuteth as of the said James Rigger have put themselves upon that day which said third Tuesday of August came as well of the said William Hayward gentleman his Lordships Atty who for his said Lordships in this part Prosecuteth in the said James Rigger in his proper person according to his Recognizance by him in his Oath in that part before acknowledged &c

And the Sheriff to wit John Dennis gentleman Sheriff of the County of Somerset of the County of Somerset and names of the Jurors in all things served and executed and the Jurors of that Jury the said Imparcelled being called to wit, William Hewitt, Thomas Harris, Marye Deuchamp, William Marwick, David Wilson, Isaac Coulbourn, Joseph Scroggin, Jerey Dackill, George Roffit, Dr. Haffington, Jonathan Roffit and Samuel Mersy being called came to say the truth of their Premises being called by the said Court and by the said Court here fully understood it is considered by the Court here that the said James Rigger for the Premises aforesaid in the Indictment aforesaid above specified &c

Which said James Rigger present herein Court as aforesaid is fined for the Premises aforesaid the sum of five Shillings current money which he paid the Sheriff of the County of Somerset for the use of his said Lordships &c
