 seven hundred & Sixty to answer unto his Lordship of and concerning the said
 assault.

And afterwards in the same Court came the said William Heath in his
 Person and had a hearing of the Judgment of the said Lord Bishop that he will not stand
 with his said Lordship but for saying that he will not stand
 submits himself at fine with his said Lordship by Occasion of the Curmises and trusts
 himself upon favour of the Court.

Whereupon all and singular of Curmises being seen and by the Court here fully understood
 it is Considered by the Court here that the said Mr Heath for Curmises offend in the
 Indictment of above specified.

Which said Mr Heath present here in Court as aforesaid is fined for Curmises and offence
 of the sum of ten shillings current money which he paid here in Court to the said Lordship
 of the use of his said Lordship.
