Mr Thomas Hayward sent Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that  
D Thomas Newbold } he should take Thomas Newbold late of Somerset County  
Planter otherwise called Thomas Newbold if he should be  
found in his Bailiwick & him should safe keep so that he might have his  
body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be  
held at Quines Arm Towne Third Tuesday of June Anno Domini 1760  
and seven hundred and sixty to answer unto Thomas Hayward of a plea that  
he under him fifty four pounds current money of Maryland which to him he  
owed and unjustly detains &c.

And if same day is given to J. of Thomas here &c.  
At which day new came J. of Thomas Hayward by William Hayward  
his attorney and J. Sheriff to wit John Dennis gentleman now here claimed  
that he had taken the J. of Thomas Newbold whose body he was at this day  
he had ready to answer the J. of Thomas Hayward of J. of & as to him it  
was commanded

Whereupon the said Thomas Newbold at J. Prayer of J. of Thomas Hayward  
is adjudged to give special bail to the action of J. thereupon a certain Curial  
Newbold of Somerset County Planter present herein Court in his proper  
Person undertook for the said Thomas Newbold that if it should happen that  
Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for the said Thomas Hayward  
against the aforesaid Thomas Newbold or that he the said Thomas Newbold should  
be therein convicted that then he the said Thomas Newbold should pay and  
satisfie unto the J. of Thomas Hayward the judgment of the Court thereupon  
or under his body in Execution of such judgment to the Prison of the Sheriff  
of J. County of in satisfaction thereof or that he the said Curial Newbold  
will do the same for him &c.

Whereupon the said Thomas Newbold puts in his place Sillitor Dennis gentleman  
Attorney at Law against J. aforesaid Thomas Hayward of J. of & as to  
And thereupon at the Prayer of J. Bailies of day is to them here now given  
until next Court to be held at Quines Arm Towne Third Tuesday of August  
then next following in J. State that now saving to J. Parties aforesaid
