Says that whereas the said Thomas Newbold on the xxix day of December Anno Domini 1600 at Somers County as by his Certain Writing Obligatory which the said Thomas Hayward with the Seal of the said Thomas Newbold sealed hereto the Court whose date is the same day and year as Acknowledge himself to be held and firmly bound unto the said Thomas Hayward in the sum of fifty four pound money as said to be paid to the said Thomas Hayward when he the said Thomas Newbold should be thereto lawfully required Nevertheless the said Thomas Newbold the then thereto required of aforesaid sum of fifty four pound money as said to the said Thomas Hayward hath not received but the same to him to render hitherto altogether hath denyed & still doth deny & unjustly detain whereupon the said Thomas Hayward says he is worse hath Damaged to the Value of Fifty four pound current Money of Maryland thereof he brings Suit &

At which day there came as witness of Thomas Hayward on the aforesaid Thomas Newbold by their Attys aforesaid and hereupon the said Thomas as before Defends before the Court And saith that he cannot deny the Action as said of Thomas Hayward nor that the Writing Obligatory is the Debt of him the said Thomas Newbold nor that he owes the said Thomas Hayward the sum of Fifty four pound current Money of Maryland in Manner and form as the said Thomas Hayward above against him hath Detained thereupon it is considered that the aforesaid Thomas Hayward never against the said Thomas Newbold his Debt as and his Damages by Occasion of the Detention of that same Debt to
201 Court of Tobacco to the same Thomas Hayward as this is spent by the Court here adjudged of the said Thomas Newbold in Money &c.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somers County
Nicholas Mubbin & Burnell Newbold that he should take Burnell Newbold late of Somers County Mariner otherwise called Burnell Newbold of Somers County in the Province aforesaid Prisoner if he should be found in his Wainwright & him should safe keep so that he might have his body before Justice of his Lords High Court of Somers to be held at Riner Ann Town of this Tuesday of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred & Sixty to answer unto Nicholas Mubbin a plea that he under them & fully just sum of fifty six pound eight pence current money of Maryland which to him he owes unjustly detain lands of
And of same day is given to the said Nicholas here of forth
At which day there came the said Nicholas Mubbin by Vetterton Dennis his Attys & the Sheriff to wit John Dennis gentleman now here returned that he had taken of Burnell Newbold whose body he at this day he had ready to answer of the said Nicholas & of the same to him it was commanded thereupon
