in our Court before us we have understood that altho Judgment thereof is given  
Execution nevertheless of & Judgment of & it were made to him where  
The said William hath besought us to grant him his Petter Remedy in this  
Behalf and we being willing that what is just in this behalf should be done  
Command you that by good and Lawfull Men of your Bailiwick you give Notice  
to the said John Roberson that he be and appear before our Justices of our County Court  
of Somerset to be held at Quince Ann Town the third Tuesday of August Next to show  
Cause if he hath or can say any thing for himself why I said William Geddes ought  
not to have Execution for & sum of money and Tobacco aforesaid against him & aforesaid John  
According to & form Effect of & Recovery of if he should think fit and further  
to do and & give what our same Court shall think there Consider of concerning  
him in this Behalf have you then three of names of them by Writ to him & you  
shall give Notice this Writ Writings Judge Handy Esq<sup>r</sup> and his Associates Justices of our said  
Court & 20<sup>th</sup> Day of June in & Tenth Year of our Dominions & Anno Domini one  
Thousand seven hundred & Sixty

unto & within named John Roberson that he should be and appear before the  
Justices within mentioned on & day place within mentioned to show Cause  
as witness to him it is Commanded / Do answer
