Whereupon all and singular of Premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Alice Giffen for the Crimes of Mence aforesaid in Information aforesaid above specified to take &c. Which said Alice Giffen present herein Court as aforesaid is fined for y<sup>e</sup> Crimes aforesaid the sum of thirty Shillings current money of Maryland which she paid here Court to y<sup>e</sup> use of y<sup>e</sup> County &c.

Thereupon a certain Littleton Dennis of Somerset County Gentlemen present herein Court in his proper person undertook for y<sup>e</sup> said Alice Giffen to pay the severall officers their fees due by means of y<sup>e</sup> Prosecution aforesaid

His Lordship of Somerset for the Jurors for his Lordship's Right Honourable the Lord Patrick Martin Esq<sup>r</sup> that is now for y<sup>e</sup> Body of Somerset County aforesaid on this 20th present that Rachel Martin late of the Parish of St. Mary in the County aforesaid spinster on the first day of November Anno Domini 1760 at the Parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid with force and Arms in and upon a certain Rebecca Martin in y<sup>e</sup> View of God and y<sup>e</sup> said Lord and Esq<sup>r</sup> the said Rachel being an Assault did make her y<sup>e</sup> said Rebecca did beat wound and belty said so that of her life it was much disprayed and then here to her the said Rebecca Martin then and there did to the great Damage of her y<sup>e</sup> said Rachel against y<sup>e</sup> Peace of his Lordship's Right Honourable y<sup>e</sup> said Esq<sup>r</sup> that now is his good rule & Government &c.

Thereupon it was commanded y<sup>e</sup> Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should take the said Rachel Martin aforesaid to answer &c.

And afterwards in the same Court came y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Rachel Martin in her proper person appearing to a certain Recognizance by her in that part before acknowledged & had a hearing of y<sup>e</sup> Indictment aforesaid that she will not contend with his said Lordship but for y<sup>e</sup> varying Costs Labour Expenses about y<sup>e</sup> Premises submitted herself at fine with his said Lordship by Occasion of y<sup>e</sup> Crimes aforesaid and puts herself upon y<sup>e</sup> favour of y<sup>e</sup> Court

Thereupon all and singular the Premises being seen by y<sup>e</sup> Court here fully understood it is considered by y<sup>e</sup> Court here that y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Rachel Martin for the Crimes aforesaid and offense aforesaid in y<sup>e</sup> Indictment aforesaid above specified to take &c.

Which said Rachel Martin present herein Court as aforesaid is fined for y<sup>e</sup> Crimes aforesaid the sum of ten Shillings current money which she paid here Court to the y<sup>e</sup> Sheriff of y<sup>e</sup> County aforesaid for y<sup>e</sup> use of his said Lordship &c.

Thereupon a certain Joseph Hill present herein Court in his proper person undertook for y<sup>e</sup> said Rachel Martin to pay y<sup>e</sup> severall officers their fees due by means of y<sup>e</sup> Prosecution aforesaid
