And afterwards in the same Court came the said William Calwell in his proper person & had a hearing of the indictment of & said that he will not contend with his said Lordship but for the saving of his labour and expences about the Premises submits himself at fine with his said Lordship by Occasion of the Premises and puts himself under favour of the Court

Whereupon all and singular of the Premises being seen and by the Court here fully understood it is considered by the Court here that the said William Calwell for the Premises and offence in the indictment of above shewed let him &

Which said William Calwell present herein Court as aforesaid is fined for the Premises and offence of the sum of two shillings and six pence current money of Maryland which he paid herein Court to the Sheriff of the County for the use of his said Lordship &

Whereupon the Sheriff of Somerset County the Sheriff for his Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord John Jones Esquire that is now for the County of Somerset County of the said Parish of that John Jones late of the Parish of Somerset in the County of Glanville on the 22nd day of August Anno Domini 1760 at the Parish of in the County of with four and arms in and upon a certain legal Bird in the Court of God and the said Lord Bishop then and there being an Assault did make and him the said legal then and there did beat wound and kill that so that of his life it was much Dispaired and other harms to him the said legal then and there did do of great Damage of him the said legal & against the Peace of his Lordship of Right Honorable Lord Bishop that shows his good Rule and Government &
