

Somerset for the Jurors for his Lordship the Right Honble of Lord Cosby that concur for the Body of Somerset County as on their Oath Present that William Bailey late of the Parish of Somerset in the County of Kent on the 27th Day of October Anno Domini 1759 at at the Parish of in the County of Kent with force and Arms in and upon a certain James Colth in the County of God of the said Lord and Cosby then and there being an Assault did make and him the said James then the u did beat wound and lully Treat so that of his Life it was much Dispaired and other harms to him the said James then and there did to the Great Damage of him the said James and Against the Peace of his Lordship of Right Honble of Lord Cosby that now is his Good Rule and Government &c.

On the back of the foregoing Bill of Indictment it was thus endorsed viz

Somerset for the Jurors that Solomon Jull, Joshua Jull and William Jull of Somerset County joint and firmly bound unto Charles Jull, Handy Jull, Samuel Jull, Twin Jull, Rachel Jull Representatives of Thomas Jull and in the full and just sum of Seven hundred Nine Shillings and three Pence half Penny Current money of Maryland to be paid to the said Charles Jull, Handy Jull, Samuel Jull, Twin Jull, Rachel Jull them or any of them their or any of their heirs Executors Assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made & Done we bind our selves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors Assigns in and whole jointly & severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals & dated this 10th Day of Novr Anno Domini 1760

The Condition of the above Obligation is such that whereas the Commissioners General hath transmitted unto the Court the Account of the Estate of Thomas Jull Decd when it is found that there is a Balance due to the above said Representatives of the sum of thirty Seven Pounds four Shillings & seven Pence three farthings Current Money therefore if the above said Solomon Jull, Joshua Jull, William Jull them or any of them their or any of their heirs Executors Assigns do and shall well and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the above said Representatives the sum of thirty Seven Pounds four Shillings and seven Pence three farthings Current money according to Act of Assembly and Decree when they shall come at full age to receive the same then the above Obligation to be void else to remain in full force & Virtue
