King and Wilfon Claim Against him Appear to be Satisfied or Otherwise to have been undus before the
Laying of this Attachment that then the said King and Wilfon shall make Restitution unto him the said
James Smith of all or such part as shall be made Appear to be undus &c. that he the said William Hayward
will do the same for him &c.

Therefore it is Considered that the severall Goods and Chables so as a^d Attached and Appraised to the sum
of five pounds Ten Shillings and six pence of Money may be Condemned as of the Goods and Chables of the s^r James Smith
towards Satisfying unto the said King and Wilfon their Damages and all Costs and Charges Accrewing by means of the
Attachment a^d and that the s^r King and Wilfon have thereof Execution &c.

Also it is Considered that the sum of Twelve Shillings and six pence of Money of Maryland so as a^d Confiscated
by the said John Kellum be Condemned in the hands of the said John Kellum as of the Rights and Credits of the said
James Smith towards Satisfying unto the said King and Wilfon their Damages and all Costs and Charges Accrewing
by means of the Attachment a^d and that the said King and Wilfon have thereof Execution &c.

s^r Gilbert Hastings } Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Gilbert
Hastings late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his Bailwick and him
should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be
held at Princess Anne Town the third Tuesday of November Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and fifty
eight to answer unto William Gaddes of Cople of trespass upon the Case and S^r and the same day is given to
the s^r William here &c. - At which day here came the s^r William Gaddes by W. Hayward his Attorney and the
Sheriff with William Allen Gent^l now here returned that he had taken the s^r Gilbert Hastings whose body here
at this day he had ready to answer the s^r Gilbert Hastings of the s^r plea to him it was Commanded -

Whereupon the said Gilbert Hastings at the prayer of the s^r William Gaddes is Adjudged to give special
Bail to the Action a^d. Thereupon a Certain John Hastings of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his
proper person undertook for the said Gilbert Hastings that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea a^d
be Rendered for the said William Gaddes Against the s^r Gilbert Hastings or that he the said Gilbert Hastings
should be therein Convict that then he the said Gilbert should pay and Satisfie unto the s^r William the
Judgment of the Court thereupon or Render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff
of the County a^d in satisfaction thereof that he the said John Hastings will do the same for him &c.

Whereupon the said Gilbert Hastings puts in his place Littleton Dennis Gent^l Attorney at Law against
the s^r William Gaddes of the s^r plea -
