and that he the *P.* Gilbert did not procure the said James Wallace to Return within one Month thereafter
whereby the *P.* James Wallace might have been Liable to Justice here in this Province by means whereof
by force of the Act of Assembly *P.* the *P.* Gilbert became and is Liable to pay unto the *P.* William Geddes the
P. forty pounds *Shilling* in the *P.* first Bill of Exchange mentioned and the *P.* forty eight pounds six Shillings
six pence *Shilling* the Lawfull Costs Damages and Interest which the *P.* William Geddes sustained as *P.* by
Means of the Non Acceptance and non-payment of the *P.* first Bill of Exchange Nevertheless the said
Gilbert Blotting Contriving and fraudulently pretending the said William Geddes to Deserve and Defend the
P. Two Sums of Money which in the Whole Amount unto the sum of forty eight pounds six Shillings and six
pence *Shilling* unto the *P.* William Geddes hath not paid or him for the same any set Content (altho
the same to do the same Gilbert afterwards to wit the *Day of* Anno *Domini* 1760 and after since at
the County *P.* by the said William Geddes was Required (but the same to him to pay he thereto hath Refused and still
doth Refuse Whereupon the said William Geddes says he is Wore and hath Damage to the Value of seventy pounds
Shilling money of Great Britain and therefore brings Suit and Sift - *Blago v. J. De V. R.*

and he hath it and the same day is given to the *P.* William here also *P.*

At which day here came as well the *P.* William Geddes as the *P.* Gilbert Haffington by their Attorneys *P.* And
hereupon the said Gilbert as before defends the force and Injury when *P.* And prays for the Leave thereof to Judge here
untill next Court to be held at Business Ann Town the third Tuesday of August the next following and he hath it and the
same day is given to the *P.* William here also *P.*

At which day here came as well the *P.* William Geddes as the *P.* Gilbert Haffington by their Attorneys *P.* And
the said Gilbert as before defends the force and Injury when *P.* And prays further that he is not Guilty of the Premises
in the declaration mentioned in Manner and form as the *P.* William above against him both Complaind and of this he put
himself upon the County and the *P.* in like manner -
