Thomas White and the sd. Alexander Maddy by Both the parties Consent and the sd. Alexander Maddy, Levin Powell, William Benson and Thomas Benson - having all part of the tract of Land called Greenfield in their Possession and the sd. Greenfield Calling on the Line of the Land that then was in possession of the sd. Thomas White agreed to settle a Boundary for the second Boundary of the tract of Land called Greenfield in a North Course and About Twenty five poles from the Boundary that this Depoent saw settled Between the sd. Thomas White and the sd. Alexander Maddy and for the first Boundary of the tract of Land called Greenfield it being Decayed the fore mentioned persons to wit Alexander Maddy, Levin Powell, W. Benson and Thomas Benson all agreed to Reverse the Course from the post then set up for the second Boundary of the tract of Land called Greenfield One hundred and fifty poles East which Course went into the Swamp of Boscawen - About Thirty six poles where the fore mentioned persons to wit Alexander Maddy, Levin Powell, William Benson and Thomas Benson all agreed to settle a post for the first Boundary of the tract of Land called Greenfield and accordingly the post was set up with the Consent of and further this Depoent saith -
