Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Ma- Academy ryland, That an academy be, and is hereby authorised to ted be erected in the village of Vienna, by the name of the Vienna Academy, and the said academy shall be regulated under the management, direction and government of seven trustees, and be perpetuated in the manner hereinafter mentioned.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That Beacham Ackworth, Charles Leary, Thomas H. Hicks, Jeremiah Colston, William H. Yates, John N. Steele and William Jackson, be, and they are hereby appointed trustees of the said academy, and the said trustees and their successors to be elected in the manner hereinafter mentioned, shall be, and they are hereby declared to be one community, corporation and body politic, with perpetual succession in deed and in law, to all intents and purposes connected with the said institution, by the name and style of the trustees of the Vienna Corporat Academy, by which name and title, they, the said trustees get and their successors, shall be competent and capable in law and equity, to take and to hold to themselves and their successors for the use of the said academy, any estate in any messuages, lands and tenements, annuities, goods, chattles, monies, or effects, by the gift, grant, bargain, sale, conveyance, devise or bequest, of any person or persons whatsoever; Provided, the same do not exceed in the whole the clear yearly value of five thousand dollars; and the same messuages, lands and tenements, and other estate, real and personal, to farm-let, and put out on interest
